

The Course

The **Emergency Surgery Course**® is a joint initiative of the European Society for Trauma & Emergency Surgery (ESTES) and the American Association for the Surgery of Trauma (AAST).

ESC® aims to aid surgeons in non-trauma emergency surgery by providing the know-how and the decision-making skills necessary for daily practice. The course consists of theoretical sessions, case scenarios and state of the art videos. The course is especially designed in an interactive format from the beginning till the end.



Format

The course consists in several theoretical, didactic sessions, designed to provide the basic steps for adequate and timely diagnostic and decision-making. You'll have the opportunity to discuss clinical cases with the faculty and deepen your knowledge on emergency general surgery related hot topics. Video-based sessions will provide tips and tricks to improve the skills of the general surgeon to deal with surgical emergencies.
