Poly Trauma Course (PTC) is an interdisciplinary course that addresses general surgeons, neurosurgeons, orthopedic trauma surgeons, intensivists, and emergency physicians.

For the first time this year, this course is recommended as educational content by the *Swiss Trauma Society (STS)*.
